Advent Word Study: Peace

"Peace" is a very common word in English, that means different things to different people. It's also a very important word in the Bible that refers not only to the absence of conflict but also to the presence of something else. In the Advent Series at <https://thebibleproject.com/explore/the-advent-series> the core meaning of biblical peace and how it all leads to Jesus is explored.

Advent Word Study: For centuries, Christians around the world have used the four weeks leading up to Christmas to prepare themselves for celebrating the birth of Jesus. Each week is dedicated to remembering and pondering a key biblical theme that came to its fulfillment in the arrival of Jesus: Peace, Hope, Joy, and Love. In the series, each of these biblical words and their unique meaning within the biblical story will be explored.

Bringing peace – feeding refugees

PWRDF Story:

Refugee Egypt program provides food packages to motivate parents to bring their children in to the clinics, and also provide the opportunity for staff there to talk with the families about proper nutrition to help ensure the children's growth is not stunted due to malnutrition.

One newborn baby came to the Well Baby Clinic when he was 29 days old. After weighing and measuring him, the staff determined he was underweight (under the 3rd percentile), and then referred him to the malnutrition clinic. At the clinic, his mother learned about the importance of breast feeding and of her own diet while she is lactating.

One month later, his weight had improved, and his mother was happy to see her baby growing and being more active.
