Lenten Journey. We will begin the Lenten journey this coming **Wednesday, February 14**, with the blessing and imposition of ashes at 7:30 p.m. The weekly series is titled *Christ on Trial* will begin on *Wednesday, February 21*. Christ most certainly WAS on trial. Two thousand years have come and gone since Caiaphas and Pilate passed judgment on Jesus in Jerusalem. And though the verdict passed down at that trial was a miscarriage of justice, the result fulfilled God's purpose: to save the world by sacrificing his Son. Christ most certainly IS on trial. His saving act, his being in the world, his radical teachings all demand a reaction. Every human heart must wrestle with questions like: Who is this Christ? Is he who he claims to be? If so, what does he mean for me and my living? Christ demands a reply. Daily, Christ is on trial. Examine evidence in this series that demands a verdict: *Who is this Jesus ... for you?*
