Greetings Everyone. A very warm welcome to anyone who is visiting with us this morning. If this is your first time, we ask that you introduce yourself to our Greeters and Clergy and sign our guest book located in the foyer. We are delighted to have you join with us on this *Pentecost Sunday*.

Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost Sunday is a commemoration and celebration of the receiving of the Holy Spirit by the early church. Christ had promised His Apostles that He would send His Holy Spirit, and, on *Pentecost*, they were granted the *gifts of the Holy Spirit*. The Apostles began to preach the Gospel in all of the languages that the Jews who were gathered there spoke, and about 3,000 people were converted and baptized that day. Today, we recognize the gift of the Holy Spirit and realize that God's very life, breath and energy live in believers. The celebration of Pentecost Sunday reminds us of the reality that we all have the unifying Spirit that was poured out upon the first-century church in *Acts 2:1-4*. It is a reminder that we are co-heirs with Christ, to suffer with Him that we may also be glorified with Him; that the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good (*1 Corinthians 12:7*); that we are all baptized by one Spirit into one body (*1 Corinthians 12:13*); and that the Spirit which raised Jesus from the dead lives inside believers (*Romans 8:9-11*). This gift of the Holy Spirit that was promised and given to all believers on the first Pentecost is promised for you and your children and for all who are far off whom the Lord our God will call (*Acts 2:39*).

Typically, there is a witness talk, sharing in groups, singing, and fellowship. Please bring a "bag" lunch if you plan to attend.
